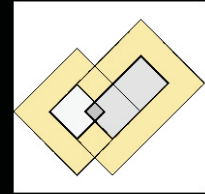

## CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

Photo Society Janez Puhar Kranj organizes, under the Patronage of the FIAP Youth Service and Photographic Federation of Slovenia (FZS) the Youth Miniature 2009. Young authors of all countries are invited to participate in two age categories: up to the age of 16 years and up to the age of 21 years. Theme is general and each participant may enter a maximum of four black and white or colour photographs.

The author agrees that his/her work may be published on a CD catalogue and on the Janez Puhar website (<http://www.fotodrustvo-kranj.si>) free of charge. The organizers will have the right to reproduce all or part of the entered material free of charge for non-commercial purposes of promoting the exhibition. If the author objects to this he/she should specify so on the application form. The entrant must own the copyright of the submitted works. All parts of the picture must be photographed by the author.

## WORKS SIZE

The size of image will have to be 10x10 cm, 7x10 cm or 10x7 cm. The pictures to be sent on CD/DVD in JPG format with a resolution 300 dpi, both for black and white and colour images.

Files will be named the following way: country\_name\_surname\_name\_serial\_number\_title. (Example: slovenia\_puhar\_janez\_l\_inventor).

## ENTRY FEE

The entry fee is 5€. This fee includes return postage and CD catalogue production.

Submission without fee will not be judged nor returned to the author.

## ENTRIES

Each participant should include a completed application form and a correct return address so the CD/DVD may be returned. The organizers accept no responsibility for incorrect deliveries as a result of illegible address. The images will be sent as electronic material (CD, DVD) by mail, together with entry form and entry fee to following address: FOTOGRAFSKO DRUŠTVO JANEZ PUHAR KRANJ, p.p. 193, 4001 KRANJ, SI-SLOVENIA. Packaging suitable for return use should be marked as follows: PHOTOGRAPHS FOR EXHIBITION ONLY/NO COMMERCIAL VALUE/TO BE RETURNED TO SENDER. The organizers will take all possible care when handling CDs/DVDs but can not accept liability for any potential damage during mail transport or if the CD/DVD accidentally get lost.

## JUDGEMENT, PRIZE, CATALOGUE

The results will be published on the Janez Puhar website (<http://www.fotodrustvo-kranj.si>). Each participant will receive final results via e-mail only.

The winning works from each age category will be awarded with gold, silver or bronze FIAP medals and four FIAP honourable mentions.

Each author can only receive one prize. The jury's decision is final and irrevocable.

The catalogue will be produced on CD, with all awarded works and a wide selection of the participating works, along side the list of all the works.



Our Photographic society is named after Janez Puhar, the citizen of Kranj and the inventor of glass plate photography

Janez Puhar (1814 – 1864), the inventor of photography on glass plate

More than 160 years have passed since the invention of photography on glass plate. Three years after the Frenchman Daguerre succeeded to make photographs on a silver-plated copper plaque, a Slovenian priest from Kranj, Janez Puhar came up with the revolutionary technique of glass plate photography. The combination of both methods enabled the reproduction and multiplication of photos. Puhar invented this technique in his »laboratory« on 19th April 1842. The Académie nationale agricole, manufacturière et commerciale in Paris recognized this achievement by awarding Janez Puhar an honorary diploma ten years later, on 17th June 1852.
